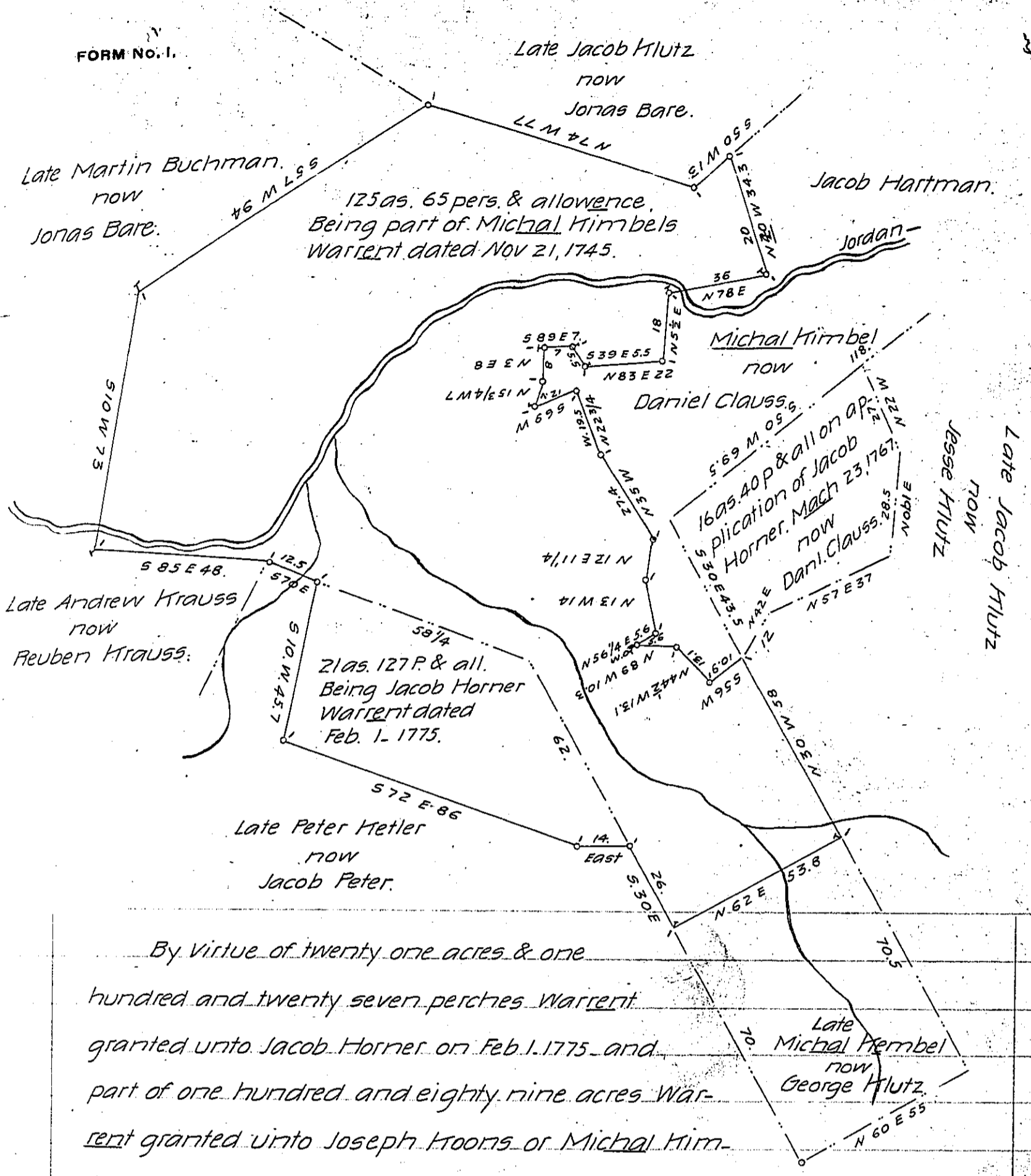


FORM NO. 1.



By virtue of twenty one acres & one hundred and twenty seven perches Warrent granted unto Jacob Horner on Feb. 1. 1775. and part of one hundred and eighty nine acres Warrent granted unto Joseph Kroons or Michal Kimbel on November 21, 1745. Together Containing One Hundred and Forty seven acres and Twenty three perches of land with customary allowances of Six per cent for Roads &c. Situated in the Township of Lowhill County of Lehigh and State of Pennsylvania. It being the property of Benjamin Weida. Surveyed under one and one Quarter degrees vereiation from the Lehigh County established maridian line, on December 5: A.D. 1864. Per
