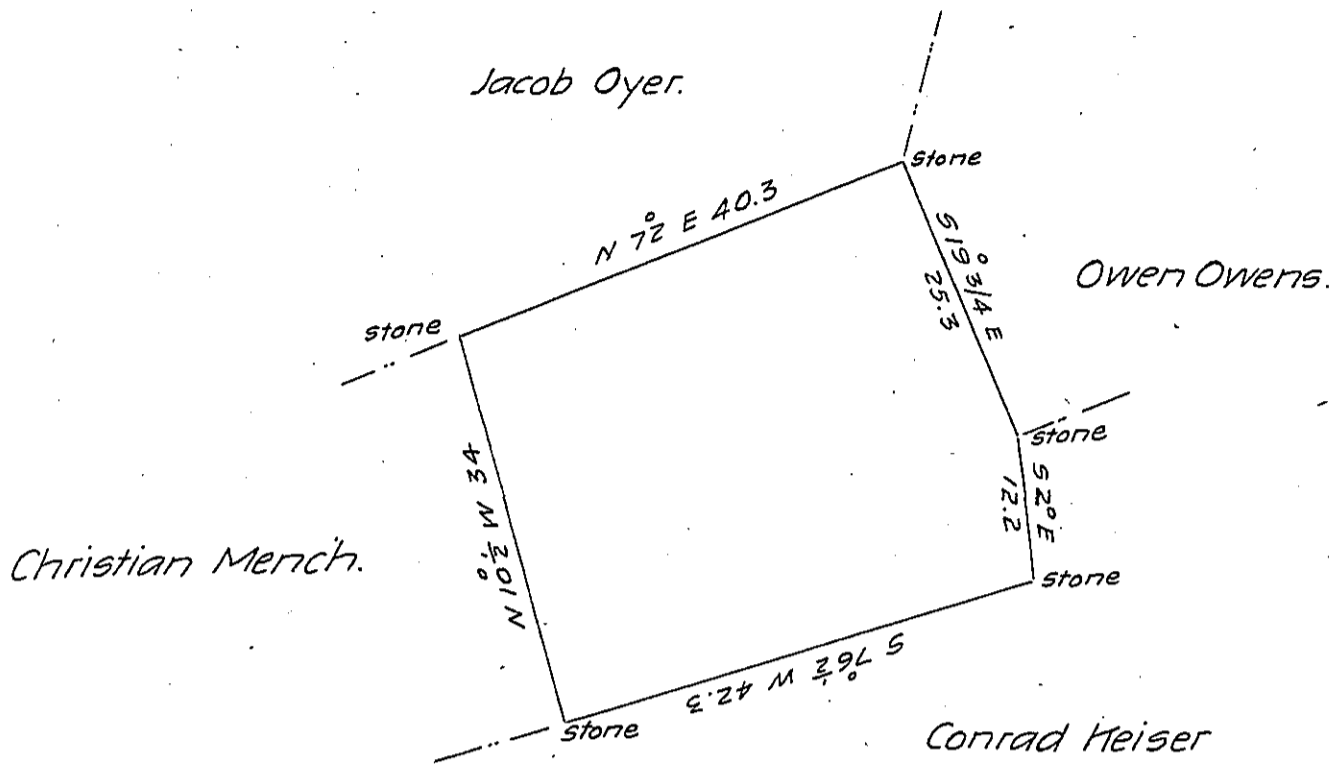


Taken as the needle pointed
