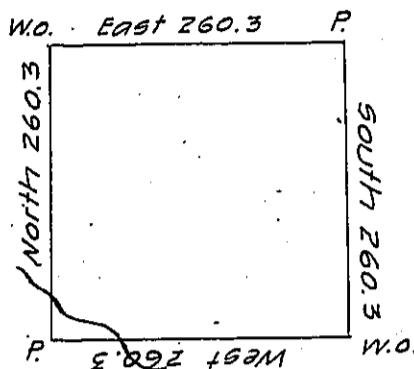

 containing 400 acres with the usual allowance of 6 p Cent &c.
