The above land has never been surveyed before in pursuance of any warrant or other office right I have searched and found that have been surveyed on warrants lines, all around said land but none take in the above land therefore I have included all the vacant land that is there in relation to the claim of J & G Kohl they claim principally from the fact they bought the cleared part (which is all except two or three acres) of said land from Jacob Wills he having it included in a survey of his farm adjoining it in 1833 but not a survey of a warrant or other office right this together with what I wrote in my letter of the 18th Septer forms Kohl's claims
