


FORM NO. I.



By virtue of a warrant dated the 22nd day of October 1770 and
order of survey recd the 1st of April 1842 surveyed the 24th day of March 1851
to James McKarty & ^{Jas} Washbrook for John Lorant the above described
tract of land situate above the Falls of Reymonds-creek along said creek
in (formerly Smithfield) now Dingman township (formerly Northampton)
now Pike County containing fifty acres forty three perches and the allow-
ance of six per cent for roads &c.
