



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following for Valentine Haverling on a certain lot of ground in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general plan of said town number 276 containing in breadth East and West sixty feet and in length North and South two hundred and thirty feet bounded Southward by Hurtleberry Street Westward by River Alley Northward by Raspberry Alley and Eastward by lot number two hundred and seventy five returned into the Secretary's office the 30<sup>th</sup> July 1774 for Frederick Reely by warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> July instant

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventeenth day of May 1906
