



In pursuance of an application No 3844 dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1767 there was surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March 1768 unto John Garretson the above described tract of land called Pokamoke situate in Newberry township in the County of York containing one hundred and ninety two acres and one hundred perches and allowance of 6 P cent To Jn<sup>r</sup> Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> S.G. P<sup>r</sup> Cha<sup>s</sup> Lukens D.S.
