


In Pursuance of an order from the commissioner of property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for John Holmes on a certain lot of ground in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general plan of said town number two hundred and twenty six containing in breadth East and West on the North side of Hurtleberry street sixty feet and in length North and South two hundred and thirty feet bounded southward by Hurtleberry street aforesaid Eastward by lot number two hundred and twenty five Northward by Raspberry Alley and Westward by lot number two hundred and twenty seven returned into the Secretary's office the 18th day of August 1774 for William Robbins by warrant dated the 17th instant

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventeenth day of May 1906
