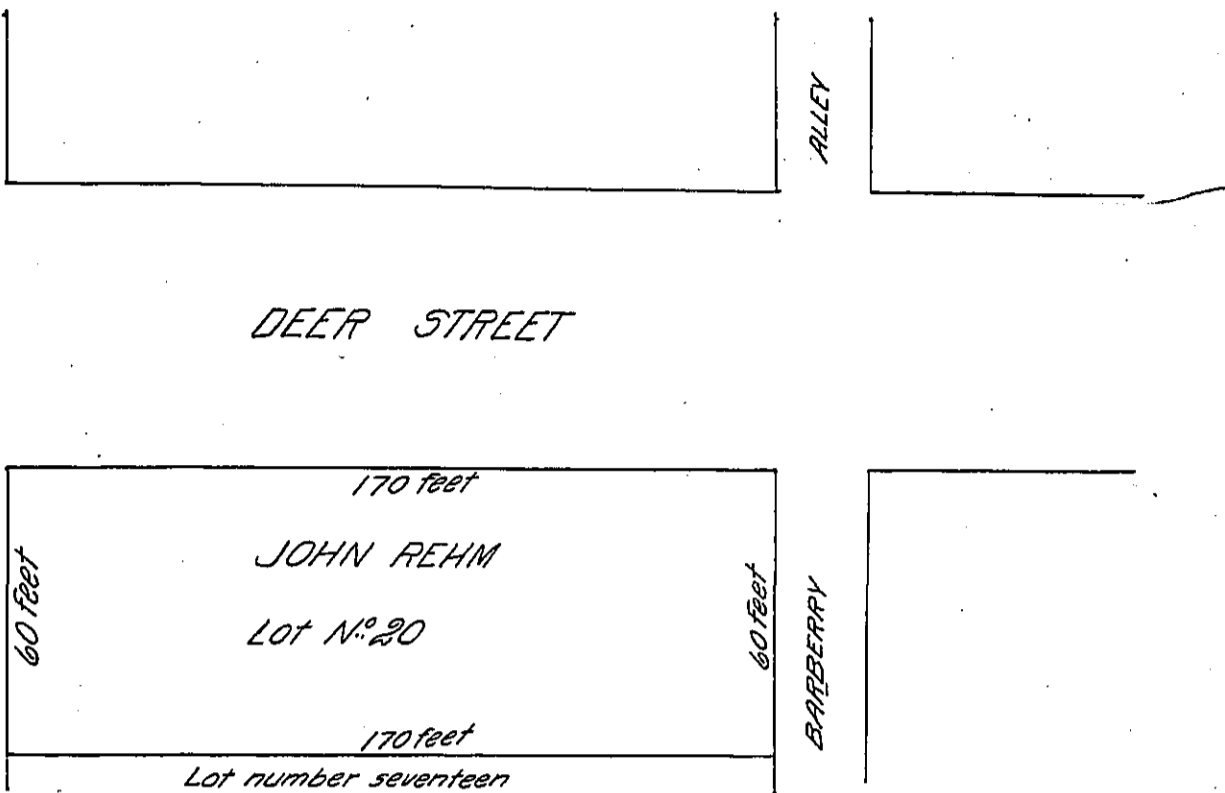


THE SQUARE



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property bearing date the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a certain lot of ground situate in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general plan of said town number twenty containing in breadth east and west on the Square sixty feet and in length north and south one hundred and seventy feet bounded northward by the Square aforesaid eastward by Deer Street southward by Barberrerry Alley and westward by lot number seventeen returned into the Secretary's office the 29th day of December 1774 for John Rhem by warrant of the 27th of the same month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty third day of May 1906
