



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3 day of July 1772 on a certain lot of ground situate in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in general plan number two hundred and sixty three containing in breadth east and west on Blackberry Street sixty feet and in length north and south two hundred and thirty feet Bounded northward by Blackberry Street aforesaid eastward by Lot number two hundred and sixty two southward by Gooseberry Alley and Westward by lot number two hundred and sixty four returned into the secretary's office the 30th day of December 1774 for John Reem by warrant dated the 29th of the same month

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this *twenty third* day of *May* 1906
