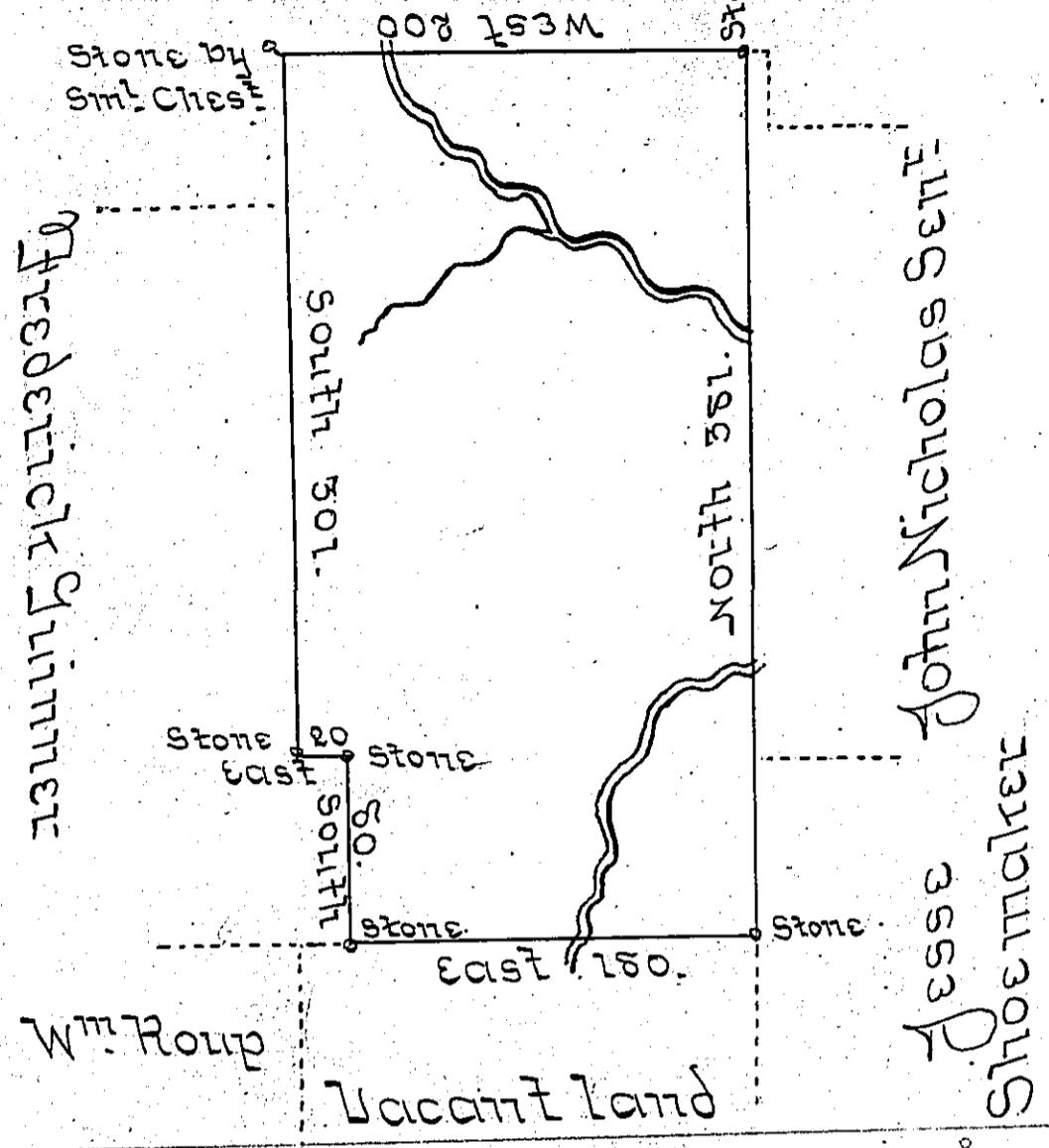

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> February 1793 Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> June 1795 to John Nicholas of the above described tract of land situate on a branch of Pokono or Jones Creek in the County of Northampton containing four hundred and thirty nine Acres one hundred and thirty seven perches and the allowance of six P Cent & a<sup>c</sup>. The above land is Claimed by Blackall W. Ball by Warrant of the same date granted to John Gardner.
