



A draught of a tract of land surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December 1803 by virtue of a warrant granted to George Noble for 145 acres of land dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of October 1803 situate on the waters of ten mile creek in West Bethlehem Township Washington County called Stationary containing one hundred and fifty acres & one hundred and twenty four perches together with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
