Draft of a tract of land situate in the Township of Perry in the County of Berhs, containing Twenty Seven acres, One hundred and Mineteen perches and the allowance of six percent for roads, &c, surveyed for Jacob Deysher. John Stetzler and Elias Keim the Eleventh day of December 1871 being part of a larger tract of Sixty one acres One hundred and Sixteen perches, and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jacob Petre, dated the Eleventh day of October 1750.
