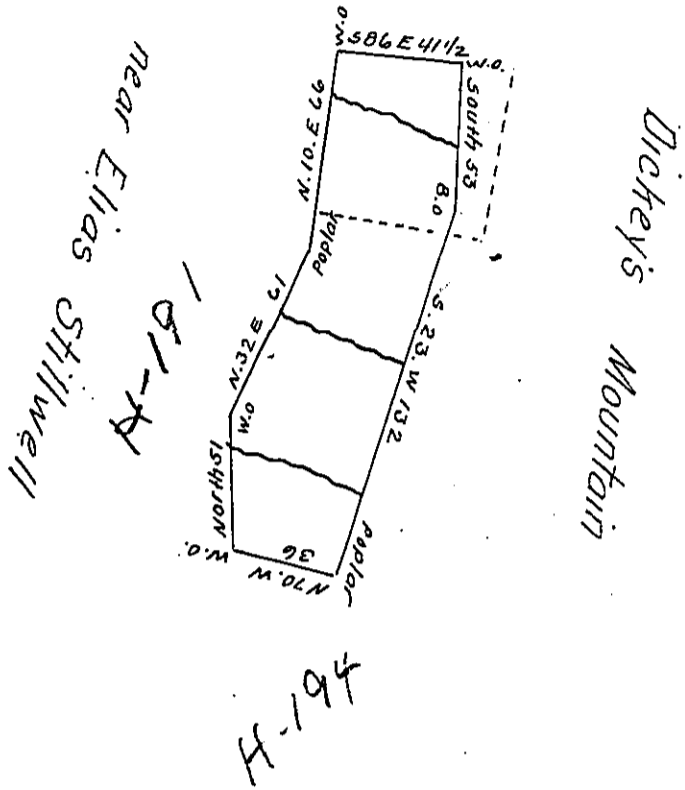

Containing Forty nine acres and twenty two perches and allowance of  
Six per Cent for Roads- Surveyed for Jeremiah Stillwell on order  
No 3292 dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1767.

The dotted lines represent part of a survey made for Richard Pittman Sr.  
on Warrant dated 11<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785. This Survey interferes fifteen acres  
and Seventy two perches with the Jeremiah Stillwell Survey. Richard Pitt-  
man Sr. conveyed to Joshua Pittman who conveyed to George Sipe who  
conveyed to John Ervin the present owner.

the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of  
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
