



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th of June 1772 a survey was made on the 2^d of July following of a certain lot of ground in the Town of Cumby in the County of Northumberland numbered in the general plan of said Town one hundred and fifty seven granted to Peter Miller who has since assigned the same to Ezekiel & Zephaniah Miller. Containing in breadth East & West sixty feet and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Southward by Blackberry Street. Westward by Lot number 158. Northward by Barberry Alley. & Eastward by Lot number 156, as by the general plan of said town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
