



A Draught of a lot of ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a General plan of said Town No. 92, situate on the South side of High Street between the Center Square and Pitt Street, contain in Breadth East and West on High Street sixty feet, and in length North and South two hundred and forty feet, bounded Northward with High Street aforesaid, Eastward with Lot No. 100, Southward with a twenty feet Alley, and westward with Lot No. 84. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 20th day of May, 1872 for John Montgomery, Esq^r.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty seventh day of September, 1905.
