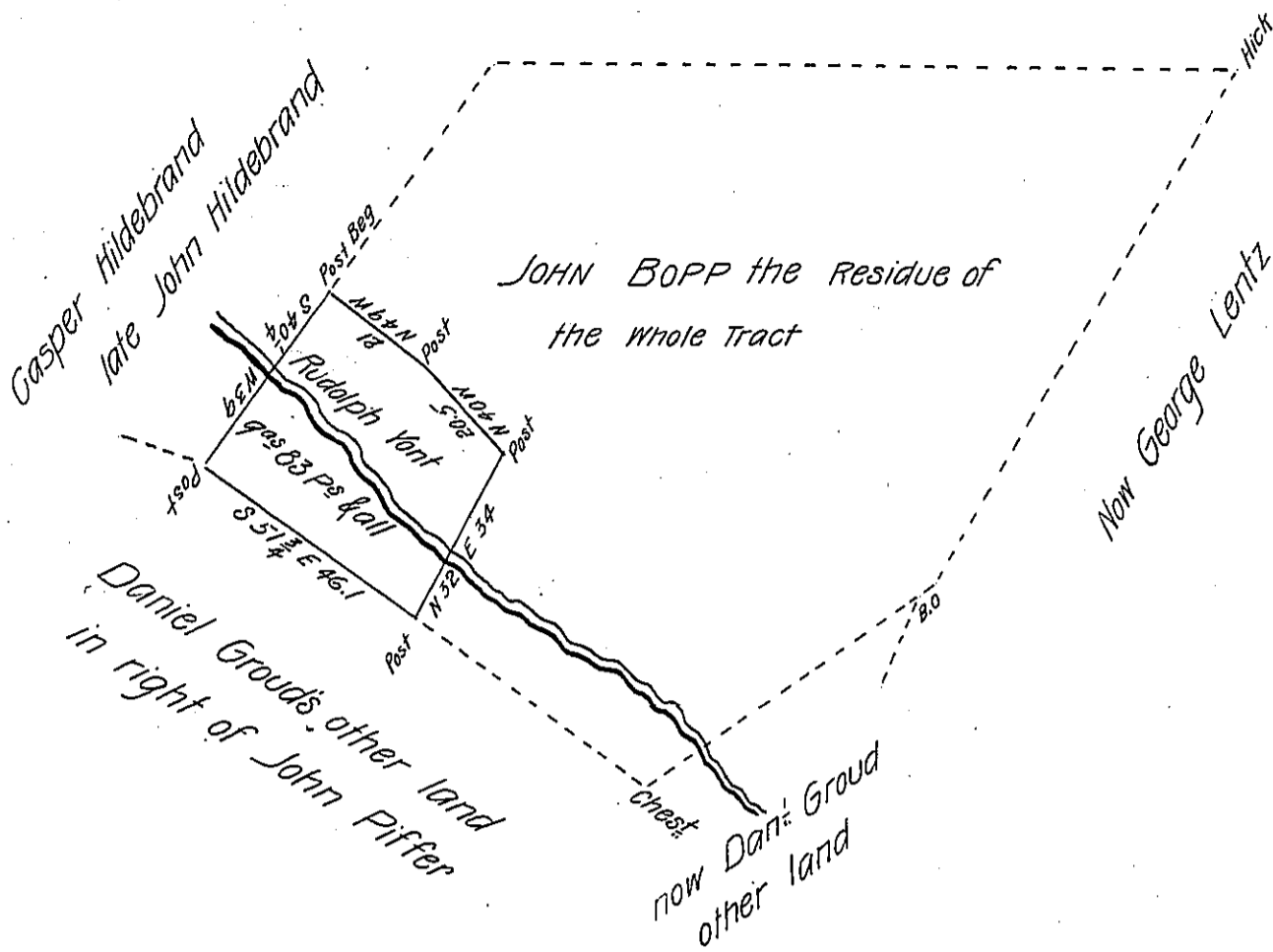

D. 1762, & the other for 50^{as} granted to David Hendricks dated 18th Dec^r 1751

The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract for Daniel Groud the present owner of said part at whose request the same is returned for Confirmation March 18th 1822.
