Surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> January 1793 to Robert Porter the above described tract of land called \_\_\_\_\_ Situate near the head of Spruce Creek about half a mile from the Glade at the foot of Tussies Mountain in Tyrone township Huntingdon County containing fifty one acres one hundred and fifty seven perches and the allowance of 6 P. Cent for Roads &c.
