



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 5th July 1751 Surveyed the 6 August 1751 to Benjamin Parvin the above described tract of land. Situate on Tomaque-a branch of Schuylkill-(formerly in Bucks County) now in West Penn-Township Northampton County. Containing one hundred and fifty four acres a quarter and the allowance of 6 P Gent taken from the field works of James Scull late Deputy Surveyor the 14th Aug 1809.
