



In Pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary government and by the authority of the Board of Property I have this 22^d day of January 1828. Surveyed the above described tract of one hundred and fifty acres and a half and allowance of six per cent, adjoining lands of Joseph McNutt, William McKnit, the heirs of John Rankin Decd, Samuel Rhea and Joseph Turner. Situate on the West Side of the East branch of Altmans Run in Centre Township and County of Indiana. By Virtue of a Warrant granted to John Parks on the 31st day of January 1774.
