



The above described tract of one hundred and fifty seven acres and three quarters of an acre and allowance of six per Cent, adjoining lands of Adam Smith, Heirs of Patrick McGee, Joseph Dickson and Widow McGurie, Situate in Blacklick township in the County of Indiana, is part of a larger tract of 270.6 acres & allowance.
