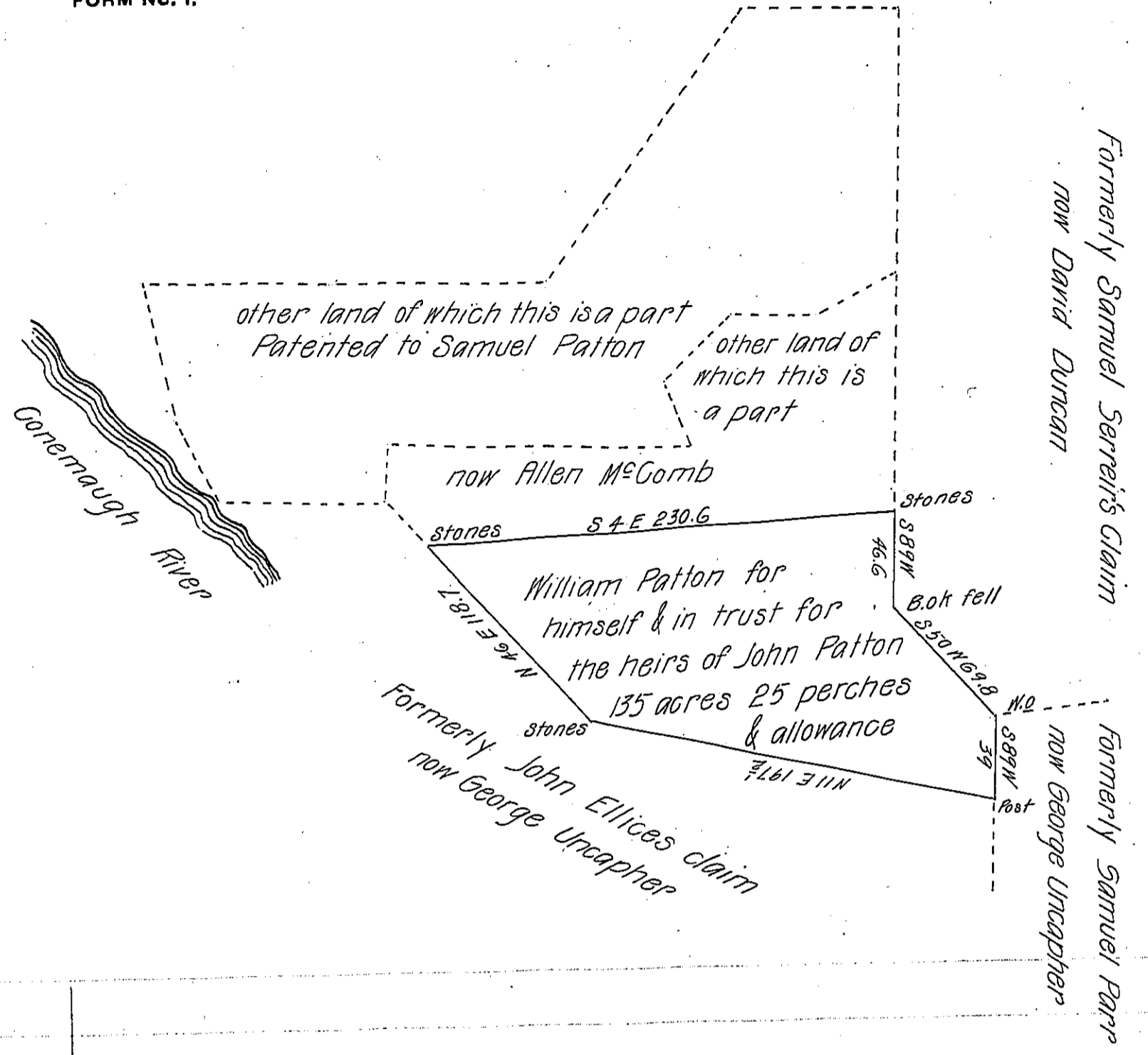


FORM No. 1.

Situate in Derry township in the County of Westmoreland Surveyed June 16<sup>th</sup> 1829.
