



A draught of a piece of land situate in Washington township, (formerly Waterford) Erie County, on the waters of Little Connettee Creek surveyed for James Port on the 28th day of Feby. 1849 by virtue of the actual Settlement residence and improvement of Amasa Brown — containing 50 Acres of land with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. It being a part of a larger tract letter I which was surveyed on the 10th July 1802 by John Cochran Esq. D.S. for Amasa Brown as appears by Survey Book Vol. 1 page 27 —
