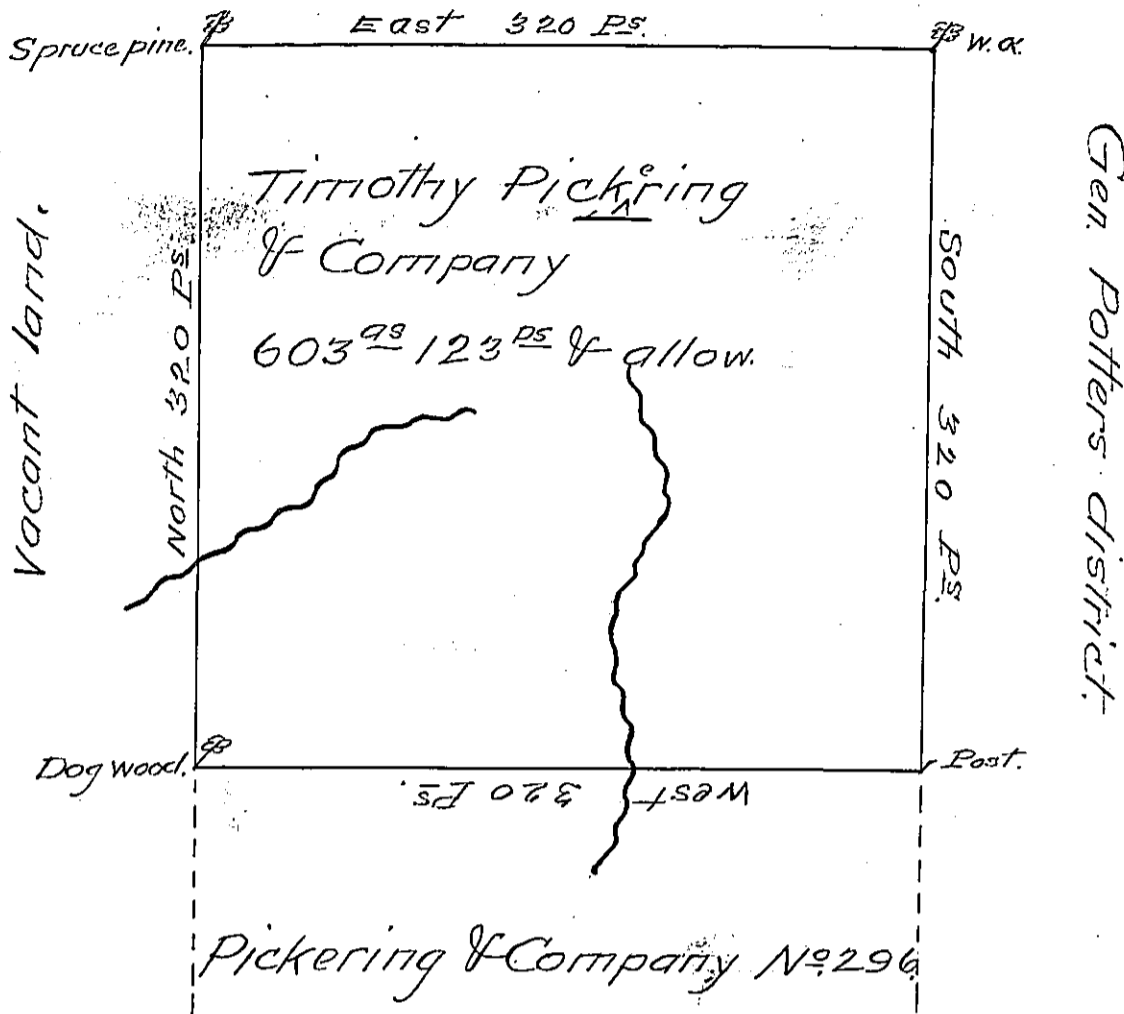


Vacant land.
