



Situate in Paradise Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 79^{1/2} & 125 Perches and the usual allowance of six Per Cent &c. Originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. on the 16th day of May A.D. 1767. In Pursuance of two warrants one for 25⁹. Granted to Gottlieb Priechner dated the 14th day of March 1755, and the other for 100⁹. Granted to John Graff bearing date the 30th day of April A.D. 1765 - Resurveyed by the old lines on the 23rd day of May A.D. 1815 at the Request of the owner Peter Gise who desired the same returned for Confirmation.
