



The Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Bald Eagle Township Centre County Containing two hundred and fifty one acres, one hundred and twenty six perches and allowance of six per cent &c^o Surveyed the 24th day of August 1815 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Quay dated the 18th day of May 1815.

The improvements on the above described tract of land consists of a Cabbin dwelling house and Barn, and about Sixty acres of Cleared land - at the time of making the survey, the said John Quay and family lived on the premises, first improved in October 1793
