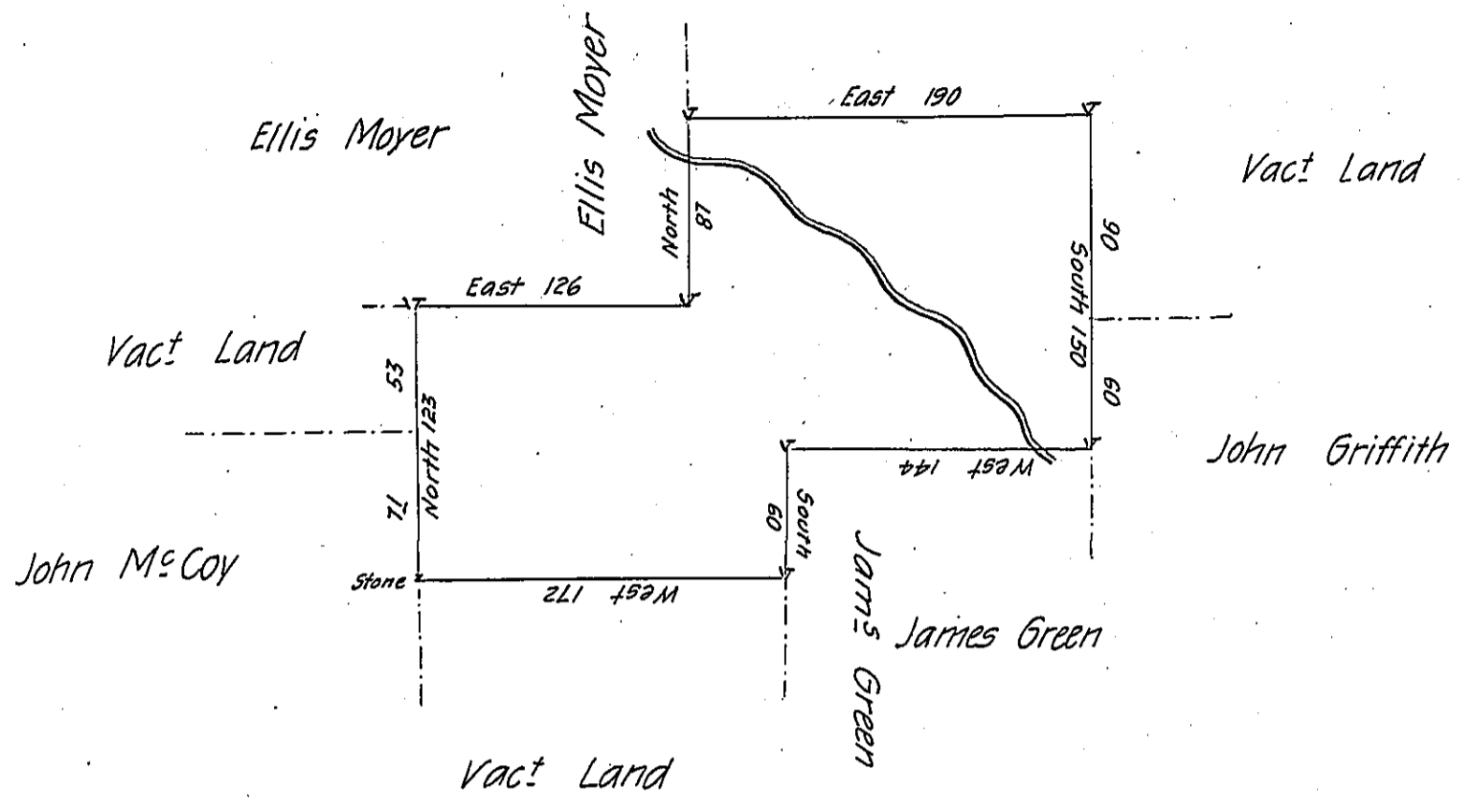


Vac<sup>t</sup> Land

Cent
