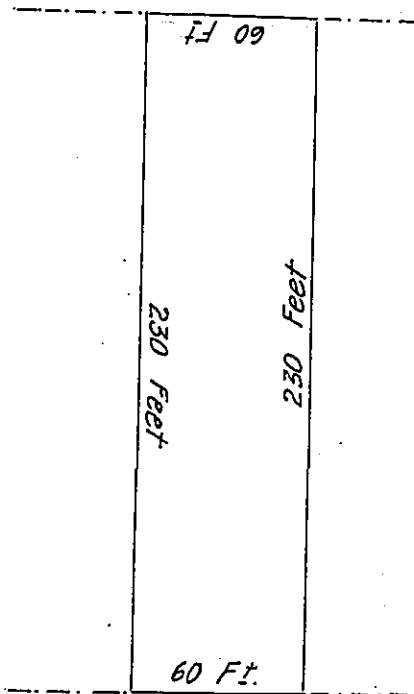


Twenty Feet Alley
