Cooper in right of John Nicholson Esq^r on the 1st day of September 1819 the above described Tract of one thousand and thirty acres and ninety six perches and allowance of Six Per Cent, adjoining lands of W^m Brown Doct^r W^m Cathcart, George Latimer, Henry Geddis and W^m Willink on the waters of Big Mahoning in the last Purchase made of the Indians East of the Allegheny River and Cannawango Creek in Perry Township Jefferson County By War-rant of 30 August 1793 and Numbered 4036.
