



Situate in Sattlick township (on or near the line of Somerset formerly a part of Bedford County) Fayette County, and Surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 1836. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of John Nob for 400<sup>ac</sup> dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of January 1794 there was an improvement of 5 or 6 acres, an old house &c. commenced upwards of 30 years ago but not ~~now~~ occupied for 5 or 6 years, house falling down.
