

Part of a larger Tract of Land situate in Milford Township
(formerly Cumberland) now Mifflin County Survey² the 6th day of
June 1763 and said to contain Four hundred & thirty one acres &
three fourths of an acre & the allowance &c. In pursuance of Two War-
rants one in the name of Richard Franklin dated the 4th day of
Feb^Y 1755, the other in the name of John Hunter dated the 1st day
of April 1755.

Divided the 11th day of April 1801.
