



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 10th day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Robison for 400 acres of Land Dated February the tenth day 1794 situate on the North side of Little Conaquesnessing Creek where the Venango path Crosses said Creek North and West of the River Ohio Called Cramberry containing four Hundred thirty four and an half acres together with the usual allowance of six P^{ct} Cent for Roads.
