



A Draught of a survey called Charity situate in Fayette Township in Alleg-County contains 202 Ac<sup>s</sup> 137 P<sup>s</sup> and ye usual allow<sup>ee</sup> surveyed on the 31<sup>st</sup> Mch 1802 in pursuance of a Warrt granted to Daniel Ross for 200 Ac<sup>s</sup> dated 25<sup>th</sup> June 1800.

Note. this survey interferes with one made many years ago on a warrt in the name of Rob<sup>t</sup> Campbell, but not ret<sup>d</sup> owing to a dispute between Jas O'Hara And<sup>d</sup> Robinson & others.

also with another survey made on a warrt in the name of Jacob Bous-ner and also detained on acct of a dispute, it is also said to interfere with a tract patented to Jas<sup>s</sup> Bell.
