



A draught of Thirty five acres One hundred & six perches and the allowance of Six p Cent for roads &c^s situate in Fermanagh township Mifflin County being part of a larger tract of land which was surveyed for James Purdy by virtue of his Warrant dated Sept^r 6th 1765 divided for Peter Sturgeon Dec^r 25th 1793

is included James Harris D.S

Note- the land above described in a survey of W^m Buchanan & Jn^o Smith on w^{ts} dated Feb^r 3^d 1755 as well as in the survey of James Purdy but appears to have been adjudged to James Purdy by the Board of Propetty
