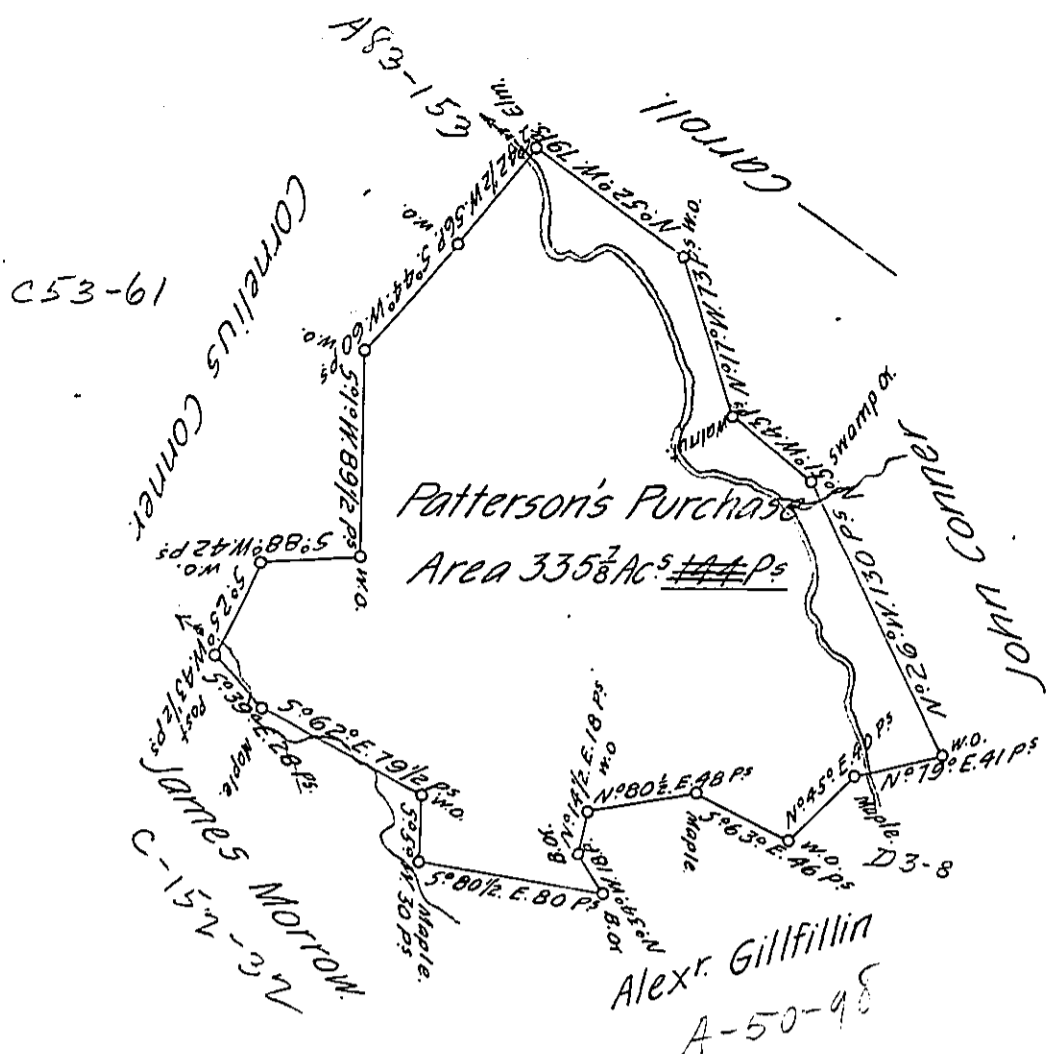

A Draught of a Survey called "Patterson's Purchase" situate on the Waters of Chartiers C<sup>k</sup>, in Washington County, cont<sup>g</sup> 335 Ac<sup>s</sup> 144 P<sup>s</sup> strict Measure, executed January y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> 1786, for Tho<sup>s</sup> Patterson, Ass<sup>ee</sup> of Ja<sup>s</sup> M<sup>c</sup>Laughlin, in Consequence of a Certif<sup>e</sup> granted to s<sup>d</sup> M<sup>c</sup>Laughlin by the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> appointed by Virg<sup>a</sup> to adjust the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties-Monong<sup>a</sup> Yohg<sup>a</sup> & Ohio, and duly entered with the County Surv<sup>rs</sup> as appears from the List of Entries transmitted from the Surv. Gen<sup>l</sup>'s Office.

Note, The above Survey was returned thro-Mistake in August 1785, it has since been resurveyed and considerably altered at the request of the owner and y<sup>e</sup> adjoining Claimants; we beg this Draught may be received into the Office and the former one destroyed.
