



Situate in Codorus Township, in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 302¹/₄ & 4 perches and allowance. Originally Surveyed on the 8th day of June 1759, by a Deputy Surveyor who Neglected to make Return of Survey. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100^a Granted to John Reva bearing dated the 10th day of September 1750. Resurveyed by the old lines on the 26th & 27th days of November 1807, at the request of Jonas Reva present owner who desired us to make Return of the Draught.
