Surveyed unto Philip Jacob Roath (alias Roads) in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September 1746, resurveyed & divided the 17<sup>th</sup> day of November 1809 for the Trustees & Congregation of Bellman's Church.
