 mahoning Township, Bedford County and Surveyed the 16th Day of August 1786.
 In Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 25th Day of May 1786, which was granted
 to Tobias Penrod for 300 acres of Land adjoining Lands of Alexander McClean to
 the Westward and partly to Lands of Jacob Parkey in Milford and Quema-
 mahoning Townships, and by him Transferred to Stephen Tanner and Removed by Reason
 of a Warrant granted to James Wells for the same Land Dated the 7th Day of
 December 1784. for Alexander McClean, Esq^r. D. S.
