Lot of ground situate on the West side—the Allegany River, on the Waters of Buffaloe Creek, containing Two flundred & eighty five Acres & one fourth of an Acre & Allowance of six & Cent & Cent & By virtue of a law passed the 12th day of March 1783, entitled an Act for the sale of certain Lands for the purpose of redeeming & paying off the Certificates of depreciation given to the Officers & soldiers of the Pennsylvania Line & Contain Lukens Esq. 5 Gen!
