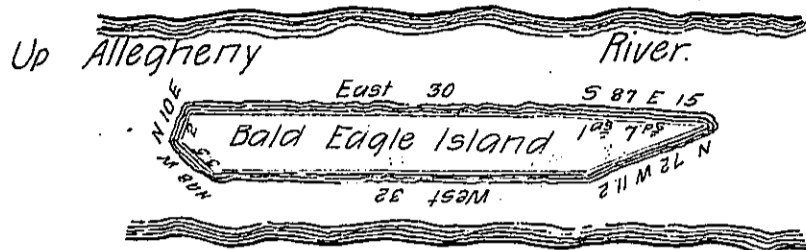


Clarion County

Newmyer, (of the city of Pittsburgh in the county of Allegheny) dated the 16th day of April 1870.
