



Surveyed April-1829 by John Dreher and Resurveyed by me the 6 March 1866 and found correct. In pursuance of a Warrant dated 3<sup>rd</sup> January 1810 Granted to Samuel Marberger Situate in South Manhime Township Schuylkill County Pennsylvania Containing forty acres and eighty six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.

The improvements two log houses a Bank Barn an old apple orchard and about twenty acres cleared and under fence.
