Containing 66^{1/2} 145 per & allowance part of 103^{3/4} 76per and allowance formerly Surveyed in pursuance of an order of survey granted to Robert McConnachee dated January 9th 1767 N^o 2318, the greater part of which is an interference with the Rob^t Barret, the part marked C. being an interference on the Francis McConnel Survey, on an order of Survey dated Sept 15th 1766 N^o 1227. and the part marked D. being and interference on the George Goodwin Survey, on an order of Survey dated July 2^d 1767 No. 4107. and owned by the heirs of Jacob Wilhelm
