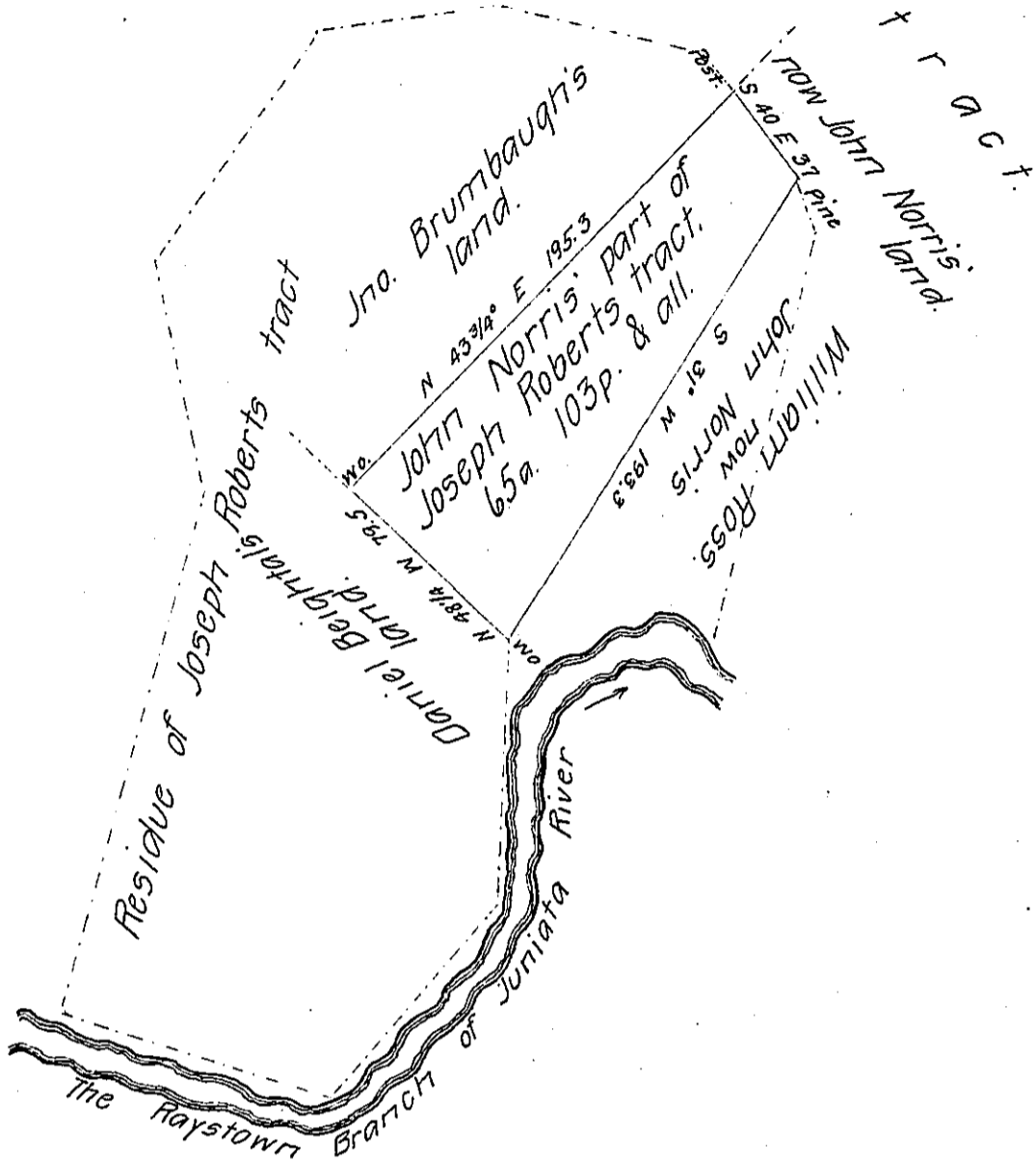


J O H N N O R R I S
