



A draught of a tract of land called Cabbage Hall situate in Dover Township in the County of York surveyed the 23^d February 1769 (according to the lines as first run by Thomas Cookson) In pursuance of a warrant granted unto a certain Christopher Crout dated the 31st day of May 1743 containing two hundred & seventy eight acres & a half & allowance of six acres P cent for roads &c?
