



A draught of one hundred and forty acres and one hundred and fifty seven perches and allowance of 6 P cent situate at Tulpehocken - in Berks County being part of a strip of land cut off from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Richard Penn's Manor and marked in a general Plan of the same No. 13

Returned into the secretarys office the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1771 by Warrant dated the 2<sup>d</sup> December 1771 granted to Peter Ritzman
