



A draught of a tract of land called Spring Grove (being part of a larger tract of that name) situate on the head of a run which empties into the east side of Stony Creek about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles below the mouth of Paint Creek adjoining land of Jacob Musser John Rotra Michael Shank & Stephen Martin & near John Forces land in Brothers Valley Township in the County of Bedford containing two hundred & eighty seven acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> days of May 1774 for Christian Rotra in pursuance of a warrant dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of December 1773 by
