



A draught of a tract of land called the stock Farms situate about sixty perches north from the forks at the junction of Stony Creek and Quemahoning-including a branch of Thorny Run adjoining land of Adam Reichard & others in Quemahoning Township in the County of Bedford containing three hundred & sixty five acres & the usual allowance of six P cent for roads &c surveyed the 9th day of October 1775 for Christopher Reichard in pursuance of a warrant dated the 15th day of July 1774 by
