



By virtue of a warrant dated the 19th day of April 1744 & of his honor the Governors Judgment dated the 1st day of December 1767 surveyed the 17th day of March 1768 unto William Ritche the above described tract of land situate in Dunmore Township Lancaster County containing seventy ^{five} ~~three~~ acres ~~and one hundred and three perches~~ and the allowance of six P cent
