



A draught of a tract of land situate in Maccungy Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) in the State of Pennsylvania containing twenty three acres and 93 perches of land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads that was formerly surveyed by Edward Scull for Michael Rishel (al Reesal) by virtue of a warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries dated on the 15<sup>th</sup> August Anno 1750 afterwards the heirs of the said Michael Rishel deceased sold their right to the same to George Stroyer who again in the year 1773 sold and conveyed the same to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Jacob Van Bushkirk

Resurveyed on the 16<sup>th</sup> January 1782 for the said Jacob Van Bushkirk by order of the Surveyor General
