



A draught of a tract of land situate in Maccungy Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) in the State of Pennsylvania containing twenty four acres and 37 perches of land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads that was surveyed for Michael Rishel (al Rissell) by virtue of a warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries dated on the 9th October Anno 1751 afterwards the heirs of the said Michael Rishel deceased sold their right to the same to George Shroyer who again in the year 1773 sold and conveyed the same to the Rev^d Jacob Van Bushkirk the same was surveyed on the 1st August Anno 1753 and now drawn for the said Jacob Van Bushkirk by order of the Surveyor General on the 17th January 1782
